All Scholarship Entries:

Write a brief essay (usually 300-500 words) addressing one or more of the following topics.

- 3. Describe a time when you faced adversity and how you persevered.
- 4. Highlight your leadership roles and community involvement. Explain how your leadership experiences have impacted your community and personal growth.

Select one of the following and provide an answer in short essay format (typically 300-500 words):

- 2. Have you contributed to or participated in any outreach or community initiatives related to mathematics, atmospheric science, or black holes, such as teaching, volunteering, or public education efforts?
- 3. Have you been involved in any extracurricular activities related to math, atmospheric science, or black holes such as clubs, research projects, or competitions? If so, how have these experiences impacted your goals?
- 4. How do you plan to use your mathematical, atmospheric science, or black holes knowledge and skills to make a positive impact in the world or your community?
